### Art Scholarship

All candidates for an Art Scholarship will be required to sit the English I and Mathematics I papers. Details of these can be found in the *Academic Scholarship* document.

Pupils should bring their portfolio of all their Art that they wish to present for the assessment.

#### Prepared Piece

- Pupils should submit ONE finished piece and supporting study material.
- Supporting study material should consist of a selection of work but not more than a total of two sheets of A2.
- The final finished piece may be realised in any two or three-dimensional medium or a combination of media.
- Any three-dimensional work may be submitted through photographic or digital means.
- The final piece should respond to either;
  1. Observational and Interpretive – this can include printmaking, textiles, lens based media or new digital technologies.
  2. Design – this can include graphic design, textile design, interior design or environmental design.

#### Examination Task

- Pupils will be asked to complete one task from a choice of either Observation and Interpretive or a Design.
- They will be given a maximum of three hours plus some time for discussion.
