



MUSIC SCHOLARSHIP:

Performance

- Pupils should prepare a piece on **TWO instruments**. Each piece should last approximately 3 minutes.
- N.B. Pupils applying for any other awards (not the Music Scholarship) will only need to perform **ONE** piece of approximately 3 minutes duration.
- The piece(s) may be accompanied with piano/ CD or unaccompanied.
- N.B. If there is a piano accompaniment, **please give this to the Director of Music in the morning.**

Quick study piece

- Pupils will be given a short piece of music. They will have up to a minute to look through and try sections out. They will then be asked to perform the piece to the best of their ability and as musically as possible, taking note of any performance directions & markings. They may also be asked questions about the nature, character and context of the piece.

Interview

- Pupils will be interviewed by the Director of Music on various aspects of their music-making and experience as well as their ambitions and targets.
